<p>p. 66 Inpatient</p>	<p><u>Field 15, Point of Origin for Admission or Visit</u>  Procedure Section  <b>Previous:</b>  1 = The patient was admitted to this facility upon an order of a physician.  <b>Current:</b>  1 = The patient was admitted to this facility.  <b>Previous:</b>  2 = Clinic - The patient was admitted to this facility as a transfer from a freestanding or non-freestanding clinic.  <b>Current:</b>  2 = Clinic or Physician's Office - The patient was admitted to this facility.  <b>Previous:</b>  7 = Emergency Room - The patient was admitted to this facility after receiving services in this facility's emergency department.  <b>Current:</b>  7 = Discontinued effective 2010 Q3</p> <p>Revised:  March 2010</p>
<p>p. 66 Outpatient</p>	<p><u>Field 15, Point of Origin for Admission or Visit</u>  Procedure Section  <b>Previous:</b>  1 = The patient presents to this facility with an order from a physician for services or seeks scheduled services for which an order is not required (e.g., mammography). Includes non-emergent self-referrals.  <b>Current:</b>  1 = The patient presented to this facility for outpatient services.  <b>Previous:</b>  2 = Clinic - The patient was referred to this facility for outpatient or referenced diagnostic services.  <b>Current:</b>  2 = Clinic or Physician's Office - The patient presented to this facility for outpatient services.  <b>Previous:</b>  7 = Emergency Room - The patient received unscheduled services in this facility's emergency department and discharged without an inpatient admission. Includes self-referrals in emergency situations that require immediate medical attention.  <b>Current:</b>  7 = Discontinued effective 2010 Q3</p> <p>Revised:  March 2010</p>
