Please submit claims with HCPCS Level I CPT-4 (specified range listed below) or any HCPCS Level II codes in any HCPCS code position (Field 44a - 44v). Claims with no HCPCS Level II codes or HCPCS Level I - CPT-4 codes that are not in the specified range should not be submitted to PHC4.

Specified Range for HCPCS Level I - CPT - 4 Codes:

10004 to 69990

92920 to 92998

93451 to **93598**

96401 to 96549

The field consists of 5 characters for the base code plus 8 characters for up to four HCPCS modifiers; thus, the field contains one extra/unused position.
