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About this Report

This report provides information about the number of cancer-related surgeries performed at Pennsylvania hospitals and ambulatory surgery centers. Surgical volume is reported for eleven types of cancers including bladder, brain, breast, colon, esophagus, liver, lung, pancreas, prostate, rectum, and stomach cancer. Included are surgeries focused on the treatment of cancer; diagnostic procedures (e.g., biopsies) are not included. Hospital-specific results are shown for all eleven cancer types. Surgeries performed in ambulatory surgery centers and hospital outpatient departments are also included for cancers of the bladder, breast, and prostate. This information can be helpful to cancer patients, their families, and others when making decisions about cancer surgical care in Pennsylvania. The results in this report are presented in two separate tables, each offering a different focus:

- **Table 1. Total Volume by Cancer Category** shows total cancer surgery volume for each facility, for all eleven cancer surgeries.
- Table 2. Volume of Cancer Surgeries by Setting, for Bladder, Breast, and Prostate Cancer shows separate inpatient and outpatient volume details for bladder, breast, and prostate cancer surgeries.

- ² Results for hospitals reflect both inpatient and outpatient surgery volume. Results for ambulatory surgery centers (SC) reflect outpatient (ambulatory) surgeries only.
- ³ Children's hospitals and facilities that have been newly opened, closed, or merged (as of the report preparation date) are not listed in the report, but all surgeries performed by these facilities are included in the statewide totals.
